










Beech Class Home Learning

Our topic this term is 'How have toys changed?' Below are some tasks linked to our current learning. We would love to see any completed work or photographs. Have fun!

<p>Draw a picture of your favourite toy. Have a go at labelling it using your Fred fingers.</p> 	<p>Talk to your grown ups about the toys they used to play with when they were children. How are the toys similar/different to your toys today?</p> 	<p>Practise your phonics. How many sounds do you know? Can you read the sounds within words.</p> 
<p>Go on a walk and collect some autumn leaves. Use them to create a picture.</p> 	<p>Spend 10 minutes each day reading with your grown up. This could be your phonics book which you read or a pleasure book which they read.</p> 	<p>Work on your counting. Can you count to 20 and back? 30 and back? 40 and back? 50 and back?</p> 
<p>Create a card for one of the celebrations we are learning about: Christmas, Diwali & Hannukah.</p> 	<p>Spend some time working on your letter formation. Use the RWI ditties to help you.</p> 	<p>Write a letter to Santa telling him how well you have behaved this year and what you would like him to bring. Remember to use your Fred fingers.</p> 

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
